The People's Charter for Health


In December 2000 the People's Charter for Health was created and endorsed by members of PHM from 75 countries. The charter reflects the vision, goals, principles and calls for action that unite all members of the PHM coalition.

The charter is a call to action to put the goal of health for all in its rightful place on the development agenda.

PHM in Australia aims to:

- Contribute to global solidarity and collaborative action;
- Assist Australian activists to make personal links with those elsewhere;



- Raise awareness within Australia about the global determinants of health and their impact on developing countries;
- Assist People's Health activists in other countries to access resources, and to participate in conversations and planning for change.

Expanding Affiliates Network
